- **First Saturday Sampler – Chameleon** - *First Saturday of the month at 9 a.m.* Even though these classes are full, watch our display wall to see how our blocks are progressing!
- **Duck Hunt** – *Second Saturday of the month – 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.* Stop by any time during the day to “hunt” for your pieces.
- **3rd Saturday Garden Patch Cat Sampler** – *Third Saturday of the month - 9 a.m.* This sampler class will be using 12 (or more!) of the lovely patterns from Helene Knott, designer of the Garden Cat series. You may join us at any time as we will be doing all 27 of Helene’s patterns. Meeeeeeooooow!
- **Fourth Saturday Sampler** – *10:30 a.m.* This Turning Pages project uses a combination of foundation paper piecing, regular piecing, and appliqué.

- Classes are first-come, first-served and require pre-signup. Additional classes can be scheduled depending on interest. Classes will generally be on Thursdays and Saturdays, occasionally on Tuesdays and Fridays. Always bring your sewing machine and tools for classes unless otherwise noted.

PAISLEY U - GENERAL INFORMATION

Trimester system (class schedule will vary)

- First trimester: September - January || One week off Nov || Two weeks off Dec
- Second trimester: Mid January thru March
- Third trimester: Mid March thru June || One week off in April
- Summer School: July 1 – Aug 15
- GRADUATION! (weekend after Labor Day Weekend)

We will establish regular class days/nights during orientation, with a few alternate days thrown in when necessary.

Earning your feathers and “duck-gree”

Earn “feathers” toward your duck-gree that includes a certificate of completion and a \$50 gift certificate. Each trimester offers a different number of feathers you can earn. A certain number of feathers will be required to earn your duck-gree each trimester. If you need to make up some feathers, there is always summer school!

Paisley U “challenge” students must also earn a minimum number of feathers each trimester to receive their duck-gree and be eligible for a certificate of completion and a \$50 gift certificate. Students who wish to challenge to earn a gift certificate can contact the Paisley Duck for more information.

Classes will average \$10 each, plus any supplies. Fabric must be purchased from Paisley Duck unless prior arrangements have been made, and will most likely consist of about six ½ yard cuts. All **registered** students receive 20% off of class supplies.
